Status of implementation of the Interreg V-A Romania—Bulgaria Programme

- ⇒ Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria is the first programme in Romania that submitted a payment request, with a value of approx. EUR 1.2 million at the European Commission in December 2016. At the same time, the previous 2007 -2013 Cross-Border Cooperation Programme was closed with an estimated final implementation rate of over 92%
- ⇒ **30 March, 2017**-The Monitoring Committee approved the launch of the third call for proposals dedicated to Priority Axes 1, 2 and 3
- ⇒ August 2, 2017 The Monitoring Committee selected a total of 140 project ideas in the first phase of the third call for proposals
- ⇒ The Annual Implementation Report (AIR) for 2016 was accepted by the European Commission on 25.07.2017
- ⇒ The Project Implementation Manual has been revised to support project beneficiaries



Stage of implementation of the Interreg V-A Romania— Bulgaria Programme

Since January 2017, the following progress has been made in implementation:

- ⇒ 197 projects selected from the total of 854 submitted projects, with a total value of approx. 320 million euros
- ⇒ 91 contracted projects with a total value of approx. 123 million euros
- ⇒ 70 projects in implementation with a total value of approx. 108 million euros
- ⇒ reimbursement claims submitted with a total value of approx. 14 million euros
- ⇒ absorption rate of 3.04% (ERDF funds with a total value of about € 6 million)

ARCHIVE- eMS 9

- ⇒ Budget: 494.928,67 euro
- ⇒ Implementation period: 18 months (05.04.2016-04.10.2018)
- ⇒ Partners: University of Ruse Angel Kanchev (UR) (Bulgaria), Ruse Regional Museum of History (RRMH) (Bulgaria), National Museum of History and Archeology Constanta (NMHAC)(Romania)
- Objective: conservation and promotion of significant historical and cultural sites located at the bottom of the Roman Limes in the cross-border area



Balloon adventure - eMS 14

- **⇒ Budget: 485,460.00 euro**
- ⇒ Implementation period: 24 months (02.02.2016-01.02.2018)
- ⇒ Partners: Agency for Regional Development and Business Center Vidin (ARDBC Vidin, Bulgaria), Agency for Regional Development and Business Center 2000, Bulgaria, Romanian Association for Electronic Industry and Software Oltenia, Romania
- ⇒ Objective: creating a new tourist product in the cross-border area, hot air ballooning



Examples of implemented projects

E-bike Net- eMS1

⇒ Budget: 762,085.72 euro

- ⇒ Implementation period: 24 months(02.02.2016- 01.02.2018)
- ⇒ Partners: Agency for Regional Development and Business Center Vidin (Bulgaria), Vidin Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Romanian Association for Electronic and Software Industry Oltenia Subsidiary, Local Employers' Association for Small and Middle Enterprises Calafat
- ⇒ Objective: To create a network of electric bicycles (e-bikes) which people can use to cycle freely within the whole cross border area (32 cities)



6 Motives - eMS 5

- ⇒ Budget: 400,468.18 euro
- ⇒ Implementation period: 20 months (02.02.2016- 02.10.2017)
- ⇒ Partners: Association Pro-Mehedinti (Association Pro-Mh), Romania, Association "Regional partnerships for sustainable development - Vidin, Bulgaria
- ⇒ Objective: creation of a tourism marketing study used to promote tourism in close connection with environmental protection and to provide solutions for the development of the cross-border labor market
