The status of INTERREG V-A ROMANIA - BULGARIA Programme - important actions

Decisions of strategic importance regarding the Programme implementation were taken within the third meeting of the Monitoring Committee of Interreg V-A Roma-Bulgaria Programme, held in Bucharest on 15th of October 2015:

- 36 soft projects were selected under the first call for proposals having as deadline for submission 30th of June 2015 with a total value of approximately 25 million EUR
- the second call for proposals for priority axes 4 and 5 was launched, with a financial allocation of approximately 30.4 million EUR and deadline for submission 15th of March, 2016.
- The Evaluation plan of the Programme was approved

The status of INTERREG V-A ROMANIA - BULGARIA Programme - important actions

In order to support potential applicants and to improve the process of drafting the applications for funding, the Managing Authority initiated a number of actions:

- in December 2015, the Project Implementation Manual was elabotared and published on the Programme website
- a list of errors identified in submitted applications, frequently found in the evaluation process was drafted and published on the Programme website

From the 36 soft projects selected under the first call for proposals, funds for contracting are available only for a number of 23 projects with a total value of approximately 17.4 million Eur.

The evaluation process of the hard projects, submitted under the first call for proposals started in October 2015. A number of 153 projects submitted, with a total value of approximately 784 million Eur are under evaluation. For this task, technical experts were contracted, the assessment is expected to be finalised during 2016.
