of 2020 Annual Implementation Report for Interreg V-A Programme Romania - Bulgaria



2020 represented a major challenge for everyone on many levels and had an impact on the people in the entire globe. In this context, the Interreg V-A Romania - Bulgaria Programme actively took part in battling the fallout of the COVID 19 pandemic. The managing bodies have taken measures and issued instructions for beneficiaries in order to ensure the continuation of the project implementation and to ease the process itself.

Interreg V-A Romania - Bulgaria Programme remained close to its beneficiaries

by demonstrating flexibility not only in view of adapting the Programme rules to the situation in hand but also by ensuring technical assistance and implementing information and promotion measures using online communication platforms and social media channels.

Projects financed within the Programme have actively participated in fighting the coronavirus as well.

The focus during the year 2020 for Interreg V-A Romania - Bulgaria was set on results!

The impact of Interreg V-A Romania - Bulgaria Programme is visible across the eligible area proven by

the numerous accomplishments in the following main fields of interest:

1. <u>Tourism:</u>



78 integrated touristic products /services have been created, including identification and promotion of main touristic attraction in the cross border area, organization and promotion of sport events in the cross border area, such as rowing on the Danube, using kayaks, organization of dragon boats competitions on the Danube; promotion of mountain bikes routes; promotion of the fishing tourism in the cross border area (organization of fishing competitions, identification and promoting of fishing main areas, etc.).

2. <u>Culture and Environment:</u>

3 projects were related to the promotion of a green tourism (realization of green touristic products, creation of common innovative touristic products and branding them with a cross border brand - NATBIOT, improving the quality and marketing of services in tourism).

12 projects have created tourisms products related to the common natural, historical and cultural heritage (creation of an network of the local artisans and promotion of their products; promotion of the local legends in the cross border area and developing touristic routes following these legends, creating religious related touristic products, promoting the common major orthodox historical churches in the cross border area; creating festivals promoting common middle age history of the both countries, or other historical common events, such as the liberation wars for Romania and Bulgaria in 1877-1878, promoting the cultural tradition of the Rroma



minority in the cross border area and developing and organizing art festivals).

3. <u>Risk management:</u>

Setting common management and intervention groups in Mehedinti - Belogradchik area, including

setting up a siren alarm system and common exercises for flood and forest fire situations; setting information exchange systems in the area Branistea / Brosteni - Boinitsa, establishment of a Crisis Management and Training Centre in Ovcha Mogila, Bulgaria; developing a guideline for joint cross border





approach for handling emergency situations in the Veliko Turnovo - Teleorman area; developing a young volunteer network in Silistra - Calarasi area (including a web platform for volunteers at <u>https://www.youngvolunteer.eu/</u>) and developing an in-depth guide for citizen for disaster preparedness in the area Montana - Motatei.

These actions were backed up by procurement of specialized intervention equipment such as: firefighting intervention trucks, tractors, thermal imaging camera, aerial surveillance drone, inflatable tents for hosting population fleeing floods or forest fires, transport vans, motorized wood chainsaws, extendable ladders, first aid kits, gas masks, firefighter's clothing, etc.



4. Employment / Labour Market:

2 projects were finalized in 2020. One increases the employment opportunities and the mobility of the labour force through development of special competences and skills in the field of innovative organic agriculture and ecotourism, food production in the selected cross-border area Vidin Lyaskovets (training courses, language courses). The second one developed a FairDeal e-commerce conceived platform, as а cyber-mediary application which provides virtual storefronts, where interested SMEs, tradespersons and craftspeople of the CB area that can host a

5. Public administration and cooperation capacity:



One framework agreement was signed on the inspections performed under the river supervision regime and setting specific rules for navigation in the common Bulgarian -Romanian stretch of the Danube River.



Partnerships for developing the capacity of schools in the region Calarasi - Silistra for a more efficient eeducational system were developed, involving the educational programs speciality developed within the project.
