FOR BENEFICIARIES

of the Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme regarding project suspension in the context of coronavirus disease (COVID-19)

Having in mind the provisions of art. 7 Rights and duties of the parties, section Managing Authority of the subsidy contract, art. 7 Rights and duties of the parties, section Managing Authority of the co-financing contract, art. 6 Rights and duties of the parties, section Managing Authority of the monitoring agreement, paragraphs related to the right of the Managing Authority to modify the provisions of the contract unilaterally through instructions issued by the Head of the Managing Authority

Acknowledging the current situation generated by COVID-19, respectively the pandemic declared by the World Health Organization, alarming levels of spread and severity and also the preventive measures recommended by both Romanian and Bulgarian Governments regarding the presence and transmission of the new type of coronavirus among the population, as well as the announcement of positive COVID-19-test results in the eligible area of the Romania-Bulgaria Programme,

Considering the state of emergency declared on the territory of both Romania and Bulgaria, the Managing Authority issues the following:

INSTRUCTION FOR BENEFICIARIES

Article 1 The suspension of the implementation period determined by the current pandemic of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is not taken into account when counting the number of suspensions allowed by the contractual provisions (see art. 7 Rights and duties of the parties, section Lead Beneficiary of the subsidy contract and co-financing contract, namely art. 6 of the monitoring agreement).
